

TUTORING FOR PAY

"Tutoring for pay" is defined by the School Committee as giving private instruction or help to an individual or group for which the teacher receives remuneration other than through the Cambridge Public Schools.

Tutoring for pay is not to be recommended for a student unless the appropriate teacher of the student involved is consulted and agrees that it will be of real help. If tutoring for pay seems advisable, the principal/head of upper school may give the parents/guardians a list of persons who are willing to tutor for pay. This list may include teachers, but not the student's teacher of the subject in which he or she is to be tutored.

Tutoring for pay is not to be done in the school building.
