Purpose: Dual Enrollment Program with CRLS

Amount of Agreement: \$36,480.00

Description/Scope of Services: Bunker Hill Community College (BHCC) will partner with CRLS to carryout a Dual Enrollment Program. BHCC and CRLS curriculum-aligned college-level English courses 111 and 112 will be offered during the 2019-2020 school year. Two English course 111 (College Writing I) and one English course 112 (College Writing II) will be offered during the fall semester. An English course 111 and an English course 112 will be offered in the spring. A total of 5 courses will be offered during the 2019-2020 school year.

Classes will be held at CRLS, a CPS facility, after-school during the hours of 2:45 p.m. through 4:00 p.m., two days a week, during the course of the regular CRLS academic calendar. CRLS will provide the space, furniture, technical equipment, materials and supplies necessary to carry-out the program. A CRLS Massachusetts Certified Teacher, who is also co-certified as a BHCC Adjunct Faculty, will lead the classes.
