




<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the resource up-to-date? • Does it have to be? • Do different topics require resources to be more or less current? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you read the information in the resource? • Can you understand it? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Does the information in the resource help you answer your question? • Is it the best resource for what you're trying to find out? <p><i>Remember, a resource that is about your topic might not necessarily be the best one depending on what you're trying to find out.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who is taking responsibility for the information in the resource? • Can you find out who wrote or published the information? • What makes you want to trust that person or organization? <p><i>Remember, the more information you can find out about who is taking responsibility for the information, the more trustworthy it is likely to be.</i></p>
